

GEORGIA FEED AND GRAIN ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The Georgia Feed and Grain Association provides scholarships of \$1,000.00. Each scholarship is for tuition, books, and/or room and board expenses. The scholarship is limited to use at Abraham Baldwin Agricultural College (ABAC).

The scholarship is made possible through funds established by the Georgia Feed and Grain Association and provides the GFGA with "... oversight authority as to be the charitable scientific and educational uses of annual accumulated income derived from the principal of the funds".

Eligibility:

1. Applicants must be students at ABAC.
2. Students must support the preservation of agriculture in the U.S.
3. Students must be involved in school activities.
4. Students must demonstrate ability as a leader among his or her peers.
5. Students must demonstrate community involvement (i.e. civic groups or club, volunteer work).
6. Students must submit an essay and autobiography exhibiting dedication to agriculture (see application).
7. Three letters of recommendation must be attached to the application (i.e. teacher, counselor, community leader).
8. Applicants must submit a completed application to the GFGA office by January 1, 2009. A sponsoring GFGA member's name and address should appear on the application in the box provided.

Selection Process:

1. Students will submit applicant names and qualifications on an official GFGA scholarship application, along with required attachments, to the Association office by January 1, 2009.
2. GFGA's Scholarship Committee members will review student qualifications and select candidates that meet or exceed eligibility requirements.
3. GFGA's Scholarship Committee will forward the candidate's names to the GFGA Board of Directors, who will select the scholarship winner(s) by February 1, 2009.

Scholarship Levels:

Scholarship winner(s) will receive \$1,000. The number of winners will be based on funds available.
